

Pool Rules

GENERAL POOL RULES MUST BE FOLLOWED FOR YOUR SAFETY

1. All children 9 years old and younger must be supervised by someone 16 years old or older, this means that the parent/guardian must be in the pool with them, no exception to this policy. The maximum number of children 9 years old and younger to be supervised by 1 person is 5.
2. Swimmers may be required to complete a swim test to use some pool features including, but not limited to, slide, diving board, lily pads and deep water areas.
3. Parent or guardian must be within arms reach of any non-swimmer.
4. The lifeguard has the authority to establish any rule to prevent injury and accident and maintain safety.
5. Running, dunking, horseplay, obscene gestures or language, towel snapping, towel fighting, or noodle fighting are not allowed.
6. Patrons must shower before entering the pool and after using toilet facilities.
7. Food and drinks must be kept in the designated area. Glass containers or shatterable plastic of any kind are not permitted in the facility. Outside food or drink allowed with approval. No alcohol allowed.
8. No smoking, smokeless tobacco, use of profanity or gum.
9. Flotation devices and water toys are subject to the approval of the pool staff. Flotation devices will be allowed only in the children's area.
10. Chairs may not be placed in pool or beach area.
11. Anyone with a rash, skin disease, open sores, athlete's foot, or contagious infections will not be allowed in the pool without a written statement from a physician.
12. Disposable diapers are not allowed due to water contamination. Children in diapers must wear a swim diaper. Diapers must be changed at the diaper changing stations located in restrooms.
13. Dive only in designated areas. No back dives, flips, preacher seats, can openers, or pencil dives are allowed off the side of the pool. No inward dives or gainers off the board. Do not dive to the side. Dive straight off the end of the boards with arms over head.
14. Playing on the ladders, entry ramps and lifeguard towers is not permitted.
15. Proper swimsuits attire must be worn at all times. Cutoffs, thongs, or other swimsuits determined inappropriate by management will not be permitted. Swimwear with zippers, buckles, rivets or any other metal ornamentation will not be allowed on the slides.
16. This is a family friendly facility; please no intimate contact.
17. Any injury occurring in the pool area must be reported to the pool staff immediately.
18. The pool may be closed or its use limited at any time because of weather or operational difficulties. In case of lightning or thunder, all patrons will be cleared from the pool for 30 minutes for each sighted bolt or sound of thunder.
19. We are not responsible for loss of personal belongings.
20. Any patron willfully violating the pool rules and personal conduct may be subject to consequences from mandatory time out of the water to long term/permanent suspension.
21. Lily Pad: Users must be able to reach the overhead cargo net without assistance. No hanging from cargo net, One person at a time on feature. No swim fins, masks, goggles or flotation devices allowed. No swimming under the Lily Pads. If you fall off the Lily Pads, you must exit the area.

DIVING BOARD RULES

1. One bounce only on the board.
2. One person on the board at a time. This means one foot must be on the concrete while waiting for another person on the board.
3. No running, handstands, or cartwheels off the boards or off the sides.
4. Make sure diving area is clear before diving. Swim to the outside area after diving.
5. No goggles, masks, t-shirts, or flotation devices allowed on the board.
6. Please use the nearest ladder to exit the diving well.
7. Only divers are allowed in the diving area.
8. Divers must jump or dive straight off board. No inward dives off the board.
9. Swimmers may be required to conduct a swim test to use diving area.
