Heritage Hill Condominium Pool Rules & Regulations

The following rules and regulations are for the benefit and protection of the owners, tenants, and their guests to assure the safe and sanitary operation of the pool facilities. Your cooperation and observance will assure pleasant and enjoyable recreation.

- 1. Pool privileges will be denied to all owners, residents, tenants, and their guests who fail to follow the Rules and Regulations of Heritage Hill Condominium.
- 2. Persons using the pool facilities agree not to hold Heritage Hill Condominium liable for any actions of whatever nature occurring with the pool facilities. Owners and tenants will be responsible for the actions of their children and quests.
- 3. Persons using the pool facilities must comply with all rules and regulations promulgated by the City, County and State health offices. Admission will be denied to persons with skin abrasions, colds, inflamed eyes, or any infection, and to any person wearing a bandage.
- 4. The pool may be closed at any time due to weather, breakdown of equipment, operational defects or juvenile delinquency.
- 5. Food, alcoholic beverages, or glass are NOT permitted in the pool facilities.
- 6. Wheeled vehicles or pets of any type are NOT permitted in pool facilities.
- 7. Running on the pool deck, unnecessary roughness, horseplay, ball playing and other undue disturbances are prohibited.
- 8. Tubes, water rings, play equipment, etc., are not permitted in the pool facilities. Flotation devices are allowed for children less than six (6) years of age <u>ONLY IF ACCOMPANIED BY AN ADULT (person over the age of 18)</u>.
- 9. A child; under twelve (12) years of age MUST be accompanied by an ADULT (person 18 yrs. of age or older) and must be monitored by that accompanying adult at all times while at the pool. A child between the ages of 12-17, MUST be checked in by an ADULT (person 18 yrs. of age or older); once the check in is complete, the minor MUST abide by the rules and regulations of the pool area and be responsive to the lifeguards instructions or they will be asked to leave and will not be permitted to enter the pool without full time ADULT supervision.
- 10. Papers, cigarettes, cigars and refuse must be deposited in proper receptacles.
- 11. No cut-offs or shorts are to be worn in the swimming pool.
- 12. Babies in diapers must wear rubber pants in the water.
- 13. Heritage Hill Condominium reserves the right to refuse entry or deny pool privileges to anyone at its sole discretion. The rules may be revised or amended at the sole discretion of Heritage Hill Condominium. Failure to comply with any of these rules and regulations will result in the violator being barred from further use of the pool or pool facilities. Interpretation of the rules shall be the right of the lifeguard on duty.
- 14. Guests MUST be accompanied by an approved RESIDENT at all times.
