

## POOL RULES & REGULATIONS



Welcome to the 2023 pool season. Your cooperation in following the Rules and Regulations will enable everyone to have a safe and pleasant summer at the pool.

### **ADMITTANCE:**

- The pool area is for the exclusive use of Indian Field residents only.
- All persons using the pool must sign in.
- Pool badges are required for everyone over the age of five (5).
- Yearly stickers will be issued each season to owners in good standing. These must be placed on the fronts of the badges. Pool Attendants will check badges and only those who have a badge with the appropriate annual sticker attached will be allowed to use the pool.
- Ten permanent badges are assigned to each unit and they stay with the unit when it is sold. Owners are responsible for supplying badges to their tenants, if a unit is a rental. There will be no additional badges given to the unit owner.
- Replacements for lost badges can be obtained from the Management Office for \$5.00 each.
- Replacement of lost key fobs is \$100.00.

### **HOURS:**

- The pool will open daily from Saturday, May 27<sup>th</sup>, 2023, thru Labor Day, Monday, September 4<sup>th</sup>, 2022 from 11:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m.

### **CHILDREN:**

- Children under the age of sixteen (16) must be supervised by an adult at all times.
- Any child in a flotation device in the water, the child must be within arm's length of an adult.
- Those who are still in diapers must wear elastic pants, ones that are designed for use in the water. These can be found at department stores and should be worn over the disposable diaper.
- Diapers are to be changed in the restroom only, **not at the pool**, and disposed of in the restroom receptacle.

### **FOOD & BEVERAGES:**

- Only permitted during regular pool hours
- Only non-alcoholic beverages in cans or plastic bottles (no glass) are allowed in the pool area.

- For safety reasons glass containers, grills and open flames are not permitted anywhere in the pool area.
- All trash must be placed in the trash containers.
- Snacks only are allowed at the tables.

### **HEALTH & SAFETY:**

- Swim at your own risk. There will not be a lifeguard on duty.
- Because of the risk of injury, no jumping or diving.
- Pets are not allowed at the pool at anytime.
- Washing, bathing or personal hygiene of any type is not allowed in the pool area.
- Persons with open sores, bandages or infections are not allowed in the water.
- No swimming during thunderstorms or at any other time that Security closes the pool.
- Skateboarding is prohibited in the pool area; skateboards, bikes, and scooters are not to be brought into the pool area. There are bicycle racks in the parking lot.
- Towels must be used on all deck furniture when in use.
- Showers are located in the rest rooms.

### **GENERAL GUIDELINES:**

- Obnoxious, loud or rowdy behavior and foul language are grounds for immediate ejection from the pool.
- No pool parties are to be held in the facilities.

### **PLEASE REMEMBER**

- Please supervise your children at all times.
- Report any unsafe or unsanitary conditions to the Pool Attendant and/or Comet Management.
- The Pool Attendant and/or Security has the right to eject any resident or guest who is not following the Pool Rules and Regulations.

Dear Community Member,

You may be aware of concerns and confusions regarding snacks/food at our pool. This is part of our community...in your back yard so to speak.

At times, children are seen sitting on the edge of the pool and/or walking around the pool deck with food in hand. While this is "like" our back yard, it is not our OWN back yard. What one does, affects all of us. Crumbs dropped on the ground attract BUGS...many, many bugs. Food dropped into the pool can be a real disaster, possibly resulting in pool evacuation until the mess is cleaned. Overflowing garbage cans are also a problem...night time critters are not welcome guests, but they love the left over's.

You may have noticed the sign "small snacks are allowed." This comes with some community responsibility and just in case any are not fully aware of what that may entail, please read on.

*~Take-out or delivery is not a 'small snack'-nor are subs...*

*~Having any food delivered to the pool is prohibited*

*~All snacks and drinks should be consumed at the table, not pool side or walking around the deck. Acceptable snacks are pretzels, crackers, gold fish, cookies chips and the like. There are picnic tables outside the pool area to have a meal*

*~If you drop anything PICK IT UP.*

*~If at all possible, take your garbage home with you. Our pool should be like a national park, NO TRACE left behind.*

*~NO ONE should be eating or drinking at poolside. Accidents happen, spills happen, and we don't want them.*

~This is OUR community pool, so if you see something-say something. You can do it nicely, but if we work on this together, we should be able to reasonably enjoy our pool for the season. Thank you for your cooperation in this endeavor...
