

# NORTH GREEN SWIMMING POOL RULES

## **General Policy**

1. The lifeguard must be on duty and the pool officially open before any user is allowed in the water.
2. All persons using the pool or pool area do so at their own risk and sole responsibility. The management does not assume responsibility for any accident or injury in connection with such use.
3. The patrons agree to save harmless the management and/or association from any and all liabilities and action of whatsoever nature by any guests growing out of the use of the swimming pool or pool area.
4. All persons use this facility at their own risk and in conformance with all rules and regulations. Individuals may be barred from the pool or pool area, at the discretion of the lifeguard in charge, for violation of said rules or for any other reason which in his/her judgement constitutes a hazard to others or to the management.
5. Residents and guests must follow pass policy established by management.
6. The cost of any property damage will be charged to the responsible party.
7. Management will not be responsible for loss or damage to any personal property of any kind.
8. All swimmers shall exit the pool at the lifeguard's request.
9. The pool may be closed at any time due to mechanical breakdown, operational difficulties, or inclement weather. The decision is at the sole discretion of management.
10. No abusive or profane language or breach of the peace will be tolerated.
11. No pets are allowed in the pool area at any time.
12. All radios must be kept at a low volume. Musical instruments may not be played in the pool area.
13. Chewing gum is not permitted in the pool area at any time.
14. Only proper type bathing suits are permissible. Cut-offs are not permitted in the pool.
15. No smoking or tobacco use in the pool area.

## **Guest Policy**

1. Each unit may invite up to 6 guests to the pool at a given time on weekends and holidays. This limit applies regardless of the number of resident passholders in any unit. On weekdays, passholders may have as many guests as they wish. Violation of this rule may result in loss of guest privileges.
2. Guests must be accompanied by a resident passholder at all times. When a resident leaves, they must ensure that their guest(s) leaves with them. Violation of this rule may result in loss of guest privileges.
3. Residents will be held responsible for all actions of their guests.

## **Parent/Guardian Supervision Responsibilities**

1. Lifeguards are on duty to enforce rules and regulations and to respond to emergencies, but parent/guardian is ultimately responsible for the safety of their child.
2. Parent/Guardian must watch their children closely whenever they are near or in the water, regardless of their age or swimming ability.
3. Parent/Guardian must closely watch children at all times. Parent/Guardian must accompany a non-swimmer in the water at all times. Parent/Guardian must be within arm's reach of a non-swimmer at all times.
4. Children under the age of 12 must be accompanied by a resident 18 years of age or older. The child's guardian is responsible for the child's conduct. Children are not to be left in the pool area unsupervised, even for short periods of time.
5. Parent/guardian must maintain visual contact with, and be in control of children at all times.
6. Parent/Guardian is solely responsible for assessing and knowing their child's swimming ability. Parent/Guardian is solely responsible for approaching the manager if they feel the child's swimming ability needs to be assessed in order to be in the water unaccompanied by a parent/guardian.

**Health Regulations**

1. All bathers must shower before entering the pool.
2. Admission shall be refused to all persons having infectious disease, sore or inflamed eyes, colds, nasal or ear discharges, or any communicable disease of any kind. Persons with excessive sunburn, open sores, or bandages of any kind will not be permitted.
3. Infants and children wearing diapers or who are not toilet trained shall be permitted in the pool, but must wear tight fitting rubber pants or "swim diapers." In the event of fecal contamination, pool will be closed in accordance with Health Department regulations.

**General Safety Regulations**

1. For the purpose of supporting non-swimmers, inner tubes, water wings, and all other flotation devices are not permitted at any time. For safety purposes, only a life vest approved by the United States Coast Guard is to be used. If a child uses such a life vest, a parent or guardian must accompany the child in the water at all times.
2. Flotation mats, rafts, inner tubes and water wings are permitted in the pool area at the lifeguard's discretion, and are never to be used as safety devices for non-swimmers.
3. Running, pushing, wrestling, or causing undue disturbance in or about the pool area will not be tolerated. Spouting of water and similar unhygienic acts will not be permitted in the pool. Jumping and diving are not permitted.
4. Prolonged underwater swimming, breath-holding or games including such behavior is prohibited.
5. All beverages or food brought into the pool area must be in paper or plastic containers and be consumed in designated areas. All trash must be disposed of in a trash container. Glass containers (i.e. baby food jars, drink bottles, etc.) are not permitted in the pool area. Food and beverage may not be consumed while in the pool or while sitting on the pool's edge.
6. Alcoholic beverages may be consumed consistent with state and local laws, in moderation. The lifeguard and management have the right to eject any persons who are creating a nuisance, at their sole discretion. Public drunkenness will not be tolerated. Absolutely no glass containers are permitted.
7. All personal injuries, however slight, must be reported to the lifeguard on duty.
