

New Jersey Bather Rules

1. Any person showing evidence of any communicable skin disease, sore or inflamed eyes, cold, nasal or ear discharges, or any other communicable disease shall be denied admission.
2. Any person with excessive sunburn, open blisters, cuts, or bandages shall be denied admission.
3. Do not enter the water if you are experiencing or recovering from diarrhea or have had signs or symptoms of a gastrointestinal disease in the past 7 days.
4. All children wearing diapers must wear plastic pants with snug fitting elastic waist and leg bands. Do not wash out soiled diapers in bathing water.
5. Children should be encouraged to use the restroom before entering the water. Immediately report any "accidents" you observe in the bathing waters to the pool attendant.
6. No animals, except for service animals, shall be allowed in the swimming pool or pool area.
7. Glass containers not permitted.
8. All persons shall shower before entering the pool water.
9. Conduct which endangers the safety and comfort of others shall be prohibited.
10. Outdoor bathing shall be prohibited during an electrical storm.
