

2022 SWIMMING POOL RULES & REGULATIONS THE VILLAGE MONTGOMERY RUN – VILLAGES 1 AND 2

Pool Season:

Saturday, May 28, 2022, through Monday, September 5, 2022

POOL HOURS:

May 28, 2022 to June 17, 2022

Monday through Friday – 4:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. Saturday, Sunday, Holidays – 11:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m.

June 18, 2022 to August 28, 2022

Monday through Friday – 11:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. Saturday, Sunday, Holidays – 11:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m.

August 29, 2022 to September 2, 2022

Monday through Friday – 4:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. Saturday, Sunday, Holidays – 11:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m.

ENTRY TO THE POOL AREA:

No one, unless specifically authorized to do so, may enter the swimming pool or any portion thereof except during pool hours when a Lifeguard is on duty. Anyone found inside the pool fence, or using the facilities while the pool is closed, will be prosecuted as a trespasser on private property. **All persons using the swimming pool and the facilities are using them at their own risk.** The Village of Montgomery Run, Tidewater Property Management and DRD Pool Management assume no responsibility for any accident or injury in connection with such use. Persons using the facilities, agree to this covenant with the Village of Montgomery Run, Tidewater Property Management and DRD Pool Management to make no claim against them or its agents, successors or assigns for or on account of any loss of life or personal injury or damage to or loss of personal property.

PASSES:

One laminated family swimming pool pass with the unit address will be issued to each unit. Pool passes will be mailed directly out to Unit Owners in each section after online ordering is completed. In the event that your pass is lost or stolen, a Ten Dollar (\$10.00) fee per pass will be charged to issue a replacement pass. Please contact Tidewater during normal business hours for information on replacements. Upon entering the pool, residents must show the pool pass to the Lifeguard on duty and properly sign in. You must retain your pass in your possession once the Lifeguard has seen it.

Tenants of rental units must obtain their pool passes for the season from their Landlord. Tenants should not contact the Management Company.

The Pool Manager and/or the Lifeguard on duty have the authority to refuse admittance to anyone not presenting a valid pool pass.

GATE REGISTRATION:

All members and guests are required to register at the gate each day by signing the daily registration log. It is very important that you take the time to include your telephone number when signing in. This provides a contact in case of an emergency.

GUESTS:

Each unit may bring two (2) guests into the pool facility as long as the pool capacity has not been exceeded. The Pool Manager or Lifeguard has the final decision and authority to refuse admittance to a guest in such a case. All guests must register and must be accompanied by a member. There is a \$3.00 guest fee charged for any guest three (3) years old and over. Please bring EXACT CHANGE.

PARKING:

Parking is only allowed in the visitor spaces provided in the pool parking lot. If space is not available, please park next to the curb along Falls Run Road. Any vehicle parked in a "Reserved" space will be towed at the owner's expense.

CHILDREN:

All children under the age of eighteen (18) years old must have a photo on file with the Pool Office. Please include on the back of photo: Name, Address, Home and Emergency Phone Number for parent or guardian. Children under the age of 14 years old must be accompanied, and monitored at all times by an adult eighteen (18) or older. Children under 14 accompanied by an adult eighteen (18) or older must take and pass a swim test administered by the Pool Manager or Lifeguard. **Parent/Guardian must accompany a non-swimmer in the water at all times.** For the purpose of supporting non-swimmers, inner tubes, water wings, and all other flotation devices are not permitted at any time. For safety purposes, only a life vest approved by the United States Coast Guard is to be used. If a child uses such a life vest, a parent or guardian must accompany the child in the water at all times. All children under the age of fourteen (14) who cannot swim, must wear a life vest.

CLEANLINESS OF THE POOL:

Any child, not toilet trained shall be attired in swimming diapers, designed to prevent the discharge of fecal material in the surrounding water. These swimming diapers will be worn in conjunction with rubber swim pants for additional protection. Should an accident occur, the unit owner would be charged \$200.00 for the mandatory closing of the pool and additional chemicals used to clean the pool.

For health reasons it is advised that all swimmers shower before entering the swimming pool. Admission can be refused to the pool if any person has any infectious disease, sore or inflamed eyes, colds, nasal or ear discharge, or any communicable disease of any kind. Persons with excessive sunburn, open sores, bandages or casts of any kind will not be permitted.

PERSONAL PROPERTY:

The Association, Management Company or it's/their agents will not be responsible for any loss or damage to personal property which is brought into the pool facility. Any personal property brought into the facility is at the member's/guest's own risk.

LOUNGE CHAIRS:

No seat is to be reserved and any seat vacated for more than 10 minutes will be forfeited. It is requested that a towel is laid on or over a lounge chair while in use to help protect the chair from oils and lotions. You may also bring your own lounge chairs. A few tables and chairs are provided for eating. Please remember to clean up after using the tables and dispose of your trash in the cans provided.

CONDUCT:

The Pool Manager or Lifeguard has the authority to inspect coolers for glass and/or alcoholic beverages. The Pool Manager or Lifeguard has the final decision as to a swimmer being admitted and/or allowed to stay in the Pool Area. If a swimmer is rowdy, annoying others and or using profanity, the swimmer will be asked to leave the Pool Area immediately. There shall be no running, no pushing, no wrestling, or any undue disturbance in or about the pool area. No ball playing of any kind is permitted in the pool or pool facility. The Lifeguard or Pool Manager has the authority to suspend any member or guest for the remainder of the season if there are any infractions of the rules and regulations.

Anyone caught vandalizing the pool, or any other area of the Montgomery Run community will lose their pool privileges for the remainder of the season and if so deemed will be prosecuted to the fullest extent of the law.

MONITORING:

In addition to the Pool Manager and Lifeguard, a member of the Pool Committee will be monitoring the activities at the swimming pool. If you encounter a situation, notify the Pool Manager or Lifeguard to make a note on the daily log sheet, and it will be relayed to the Pool Committee for further action.

PROHIBITED IN THE POOL AREA

PERMITTED IN THE POOL AREA

- Alcoholic beverages of any kind
- Throwing of balls or any other objects
- Glass containers or bottles
- Inner tubes, water wings and flotation devices.
- Smoking of any tobacco products
- Barbecue grills
- Weapons of any kind
- Thong swimsuits
- Pets are not allowed in the pool area or tied to the fence.

- Food permitted at tables or in grassy area
- Portable TVs, radios – on grassy area and played at a suitable volume
- Coolers and thermos
- Cell Phones – we ask that you be courteous

These rules are for you and your family’s safety and enjoyment. Thank you for your cooperation and enjoy the summer swimming season.
